COMMON ENTRANCE TEST - 2003

Admission to I semester / I year MBBS / BDS / BAMS / BHMS / BUMS / Naturopathy / Yoga /
BE / B.Tech. / B. Arch. Courses

1. Applications as per prescribed form are invited from eligible candidates for registration to the 'Common Entrance Test 2003' for admission to first semester / first year MBBS / BDS / BAMS / BHMS / BUMS / Naturopathy / Yoga / BE / B.Tech. / B.Arch. courses in the educational institutions (the details of which shall be made available on the date of CET) in the state of Karnataka for the academic year 2003-04.
2. The Common Entrance Test will be the basis for admission of candidates to the first semester or first year of Government seats of the above courses in the institutions which are affiliated to any of the Universities in Karnataka for the year 2003-04.
3. **ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY** : The applicant should,
 - (a) for Engineering / Technology / Architecture courses, have passed Karnataka 2nd PUC / 12th Std. or equivalent exam with PHYSICS & MATHEMATICS alongwith CHEMISTRY / BIO-TECHNOLOGY / COMPUTER SCIENCE / ELECTRONICS / INFORMATION SCIENCE / BIOLOGY as optional subjects with ENGLISH as one of the languages of study and obtained atleast 45% marks in the optional subjects. (35% in the case of SC / ST / Category-I candidates). Provided that the candidates who are interested in joining Architecture course shall have to pass an Aptitude test, conducted by CET Cell.
 - (b) for Medical / Dental / Ayurveda / Homoeopathy / Unani / Naturopathy / Yoga courses, have passed Karnataka 2nd PUC / 12th std. or equivalent exam with PHYSICS, CHEMISTRY & BIOLOGY as optional subjects with ENGLISH as one of the languages of study and obtained atleast 50% marks in the PCB group. (40% in the case of SC / ST / Category-I candidates). Provided that for Dental course, the candidate must have secured 50% marks in the optional subjects including English subject.
 - (c) for admission to Medical / Dental / Ayurveda / Homoeopathy / Unani / Naturopathy / Yoga courses, have completed the age of 17 years as on 31st December 2003.

4. **SUPPLY OF BROCHURE WITH APPLICATION FORM :**

Within the state of Karnataka, brochure with application form will be supplied through the schools and colleges in which the candidate studied or appeared for 12th std. or 2nd PUC examination upon submission of a demand draft for **Rs. 500/-** to the principals in advance, drawn in favour of "**The Special Officer, CET Cell, Bangalore**" payable at Bangalore and **Rs. 350/-** for SC / ST / Category-1 candidates.

The repeater candidates and ex-students who have passed the qualifying examination in the state of Karnataka are also required to procure the brochure with application form through the respective schools and colleges of their study or exam.

Candidates who are studying or who had studied 12th std. or equivalent exam and appeared for examination in any part of India outside the state of Karnataka can procure the brochure with application form by Speed Post, by sending a self addressed cloth lined envelope of size 25 cm x 30 cm along with a demand draft for **Rs. 550/-** drawn in favour of "**The Special Officer, CET Cell, Bangalore**" payable at Bangalore and the candidates residing outside India can procure the brochure with application form by sending a demand draft for **Rs.1000/-**.

APPLY THROUGH INTERNET : This time, to facilitate the candidates from both Karnataka and outside Karnataka to apply for 'CET-2003', the application and brochure is also made available on the CET Website : <http://kar.nic.in/cet>. The candidates can apply through Internet, by following the procedure detailed below :

- Open the CET Website <http://kar.nic.in/cet> - Go to item 5 of chapter-1 of the brochure - Read the instructions detailed for filling the application form.
- Go to the application part - Start entering your data / particulars in the application form - For any doubts regarding filling the form, open the brochure for clarification.
- After all entries are over, click SUBMIT - Inturn you will get a confirmation from the computer for acceptance of your application form through a number.
- Download the filled application form on an A4 size executive bond paper - Affix your passport size photograph in the space provided - Sign on both the places reserved for candidate's signature on the downloaded filled application form - Ask your parents / guardian to sign on the application form in the space provided.
- Enclose the demand draft purchased as the application fee (as the case may be) to the downloaded filled application form.
- Keep both the demand draft and the downloaded filled application form in an envelope addressed to The Special Officer, Common Entrance Test Cell, Sampige Road, 18th Cross, Malleshwaram, Bangalore - 560 003 - Send the envelope by Speed Post only.
- The details of the enclosed demand draft should be filled at the space provided in the application form.

Note : The downloaded filled application form should accompany the application fee in the form of demand draft as per column(4) supra. Mere applications which do not accompany the specified application fee will not be considered and rejected limine.

The contents on the self addressed envelope should be in English or Kannada language only. The cover in which the demand draft and self addressed envelope are sent should be boldly superscribed with the words "**REQUEST FOR CET - 2003 BROCHURE**" and should be sent individually to the address of the Special Officer by "Speed Post" only.

CET Cell will not take the responsibility, if the envelope is sent through courier or any other private arrangement and also for the incomplete and insufficient addresses on the envelope.

Please read the instructions detailed in Item - 5 of Chapter - 1 of the 'CET-2003' brochure before filling the application form and for other details relating to CET-2003.

In view of the Judgement of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 31-10-2002 in T. M. A. Pai Foundation case, the details relating to sharing of seats for Karnataka students, seat selection procedure, schedule of seat selection process and fee structure for various courses and colleges is subject to final decision of the Government and the rules / orders passed by the Government in this regard and also the orders of the Hon'ble Court, which will be notified in a separate booklet and the same will be made available to all candidates who appear for the Common Entrance Test - 2003 at the respective CET examination centres.

The candidates from outside Karnataka can also write the Common Entrance Test - 2003. However, the seats in Government / University / Aided courses in aided colleges will not be offered to such candidates. As regards seats in un-aided colleges, the details of seats available, if any, and the procedure of allotment, if seats are available, will be notified subsequently and will be subject to the above condition.
