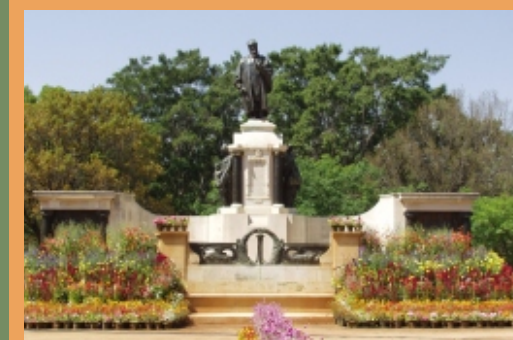

**2nd CRSI-RSC Symposium
31st January 2008**



The 10th CRSI National Symposium in Chemistry, NSC-10 will be held at the Indian Institute of Science from 1st to 3rd February, 2008, under the auspices of the Chemical Research Society of India (CRSI). This annual symposium was initiated by the CRSI to foster exchange of ideas and create opportunities for collaborative endeavors in emerging frontier interdisciplinary areas. The CRSI was conceptualized in 1999 at a National Symposium in Chemistry held at IISc, Bangalore, in connection with the Golden Jubilee celebration of India's Independence. In subsequent years, NSC symposia were held at IICT (Hyderabad), Panjab University (Chandigarh), NCL (Pune), CLRI (Chennai), IIT (Kanpur), IACS (Kolkata), IIT (Bombay), and most recently in the University of Delhi. CRSI also initiated a joint one-day symposium with the Royal Society of Chemistry (UK) in 2007. This joint symposium aims at bringing young talented researchers from both countries to deliberate on specific frontier topics and this time it will be held on 31st January, 2008.

The faculty of the Division of Chemical Sciences is particularly delighted to be able to host NSC-10 on the eve of the centenary celebrations of the Indian Institute of Science. The centenary of the Institute will be celebrated during a year-long period by conducting a large number of such events. Hosting the 10th National Symposium in Chemistry is particularly befitting as the Chemical Sciences activity at the Institute began right from its inception in 1909, thus making it the centenary of the division as well.



About NSC-10

NSC-10 will include medal lectures and poster presentations, in addition to special lectures by eminent chemists from India and abroad. In addition, there would also be a special half-day mini-symposium on "Strong Manifestations of Weak Interactions".

The organizing Committee of NSC-10 cordially invites all scientists, teachers and students to participate in NSC-10. Participants interested in presenting a poster are requested to upload a one-page abstract as per the format guidelines provided. The list of the accepted abstracts will be uploaded on CRSI website by November 15, 2007. Four best-poster awards will be given.

The one-page abstract should be created using MS Word, Times New Roman 10 pt, normal font, single space. Use A4 size paper with margins-top/bottom:1 inch; left/right: 1.25 inches. Cite the references in parentheses e.g. Chandrasekaran et al [1] in the text. References should be typed in 9 point, normal font and single space. The entire abstract including text, figures, equations, structures, schemes and references must be sent as a [authorname.doc] file. The printed areas should be 5.8 inches (w) x 9.7 inches (l).
